It is also "Father's Day"! As well as ensuring that we spend money on various macho gifts for the dads among us it also excludes those who are not fathers! Jeannette has made sure not to exclude anyone by renaming it "Men's and Boy's Day" and giving out flowers, remembering that one does not need to be a biological father to give fatherly care or advice. We pray for fathers and those who play a fatherly role!

Next week is the Third Session of the 43rd. Synod! That means it is the 3rd sitting of the 43rd gathering together of elected Synod Reps.
