## From Rob

Dear friends

Today, is officially All Souls Day! All Souls Day provides an opportunity to remember the faithful people of God in every age and celebrate our continuing unity with them in the "communion of saints". All Saints Day on November 1st was originally the day set aside to celebrate the saints who did not have their own special day of celebration. So All Saints Day is not for people such as Peter and Paul or James and John etc. but for all the other saints.

When we celebrate all the "other" saints who are obscure and unknown it seems we may be including some of the faithful souls known to us but not officially recognised as saints. In fact the word saint translates a word which means holy or sanctified by their dedication to God. It is for this reason that I have no difficulty blending All Saints and All Souls Days together. I don't imagine God has a separate section for Saints, Other Saints, and Ordinary Souls!

One of the faithful people we remember this week is Ted Moore who moved on into Eternal Life on Monday this week after 95 years. Ted's

funeral was on Friday and it was great to hear about Ted's life and work after coming to Canberra in 1925! He spent most of his working life with CSIRO and was still offering assistance there up until about five years ago! Ted was also a member of the St Philip's family in his more active years and was a very generous supporter of daughter Robin's work at the Northbourne Community Centre.

Our Annual Electoral Meeting elected a good blend of people for the 2004 Parish Council, although we still have a vacancy for a People's Warden. The hope in having an election at this time is to blend the outgoing Parish Council with the incoming one in a changing over period until the Annual Meeting in February. With the combination of a number retiring from Parish Council and overlapping new members meetings will fit snugly into the Rectory!
