You are warmly invited to attend a public seminar at St Mark's, on Thursday 15 July at 7.30pm on this topic, specifically, on the reading of such a text in the contemporary church.

There will be four speakers: Matthew Anstey (Old Testament), Heather Thomson (Systematic Theology), Ranjini Rebera (Communication & Gender), and Jeanette Mathews (Homiletics). After their presentations, about 30 minutes will be given to questions and comments from those attending. The focus of the talks will be on the issues that emerge from a careful reading of the text, particularly hermeneutical, theological, social, and pastoral.

The seminar this year is integrated with The Pentateuch residential school subject at St Mark's, whose twenty or so participants will be in attendance as part of their educational experience. We hope that this event will become an annual series at St Mark's, entitled "Reading Scripture in the Contemporary Church".
