At St Philip's on 17th and 18th September

Hildegard (b.1098) was the abbess of the monastery at Rupertsberg near Bingen from 1136 until her death in 1179. She wrote scientific observations and recorded her visions as well as theological works.

Hildegard exercised a wide influence numbering emperors, kings, prelates and saints among her correspondents. Hildegard's feast day is 17th September!
