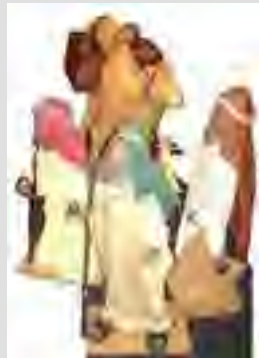
The Anglican Church of St Philip's O'Connor, Canberra, ACT, Australia
