Greetings to all!

We celebrate St Columba with the Iona Sunday Communion today and the Rev'd Jeannette McHugh is our preacher! We also welcome Atticus Hunter Hill in baptism.

Today we also give thanks for Marie Lewis and Gordon Arthur (bishop)! The nice connection is that Gordon was a friend and mentor for Jeannette and Marie of course a core member of St Philip's from the beginning.

St Columba's Day has memories for me too! It was ten years ago on 9th June that I was in St Columba's Cathedral in Derry (or Londonderry for the celebration on the 1400th anniversary of the death of Columba. Columba is also known as Columb or ColmCille! I was there as part of the Pilgrimage to mark the occasion and the cathedral was packed, Bishop James Mehaffey welcomed all present to share the Eucharist and his address emphasized unity over division (Remembering that Londonderry was where so much bombing and inter religious strife was still taking place in 1997)

Bishop Mehaffey's address focused on the journey of the pilgrims who had gathered for the event commenting that walking at 3mph (5kph) allowed time to reflect. He recommended that we all get to know the 3mph God rather than a 60mph God! He also pointed out Columba's example of repentance and devotion after the battle for which he believed he was responsible.

After the worship we walked to the River Foyle where a curragh (boat) was launched to begin the re-enactment of the voyage to Iona off the coast of Scotland where Columba established the community in 563.
