This week, 4-10 June is the week of International Church Action for Peace in Palestine and Israel. On Wednesday the Ecumenical Heads of Churches delivered a statement to the Australian government about a balanced way ahead for Palestine and Israel. Later that day a number of interested Anglicans gathered to hear the Anglican Primate, Archbishop Phillip Aspinall discuss aspects of his visit to Palestine and Israel and elements of the statement! I was really heartened by the group of our St Philip's people who gathered for the discussion with the Archbishop and I do hope we can establish a Palestine-Israel interest group here at St Philip's. We are also asked to pray for the situation in Myanmar (Burma) following weeks of wrangling over the offers of aid to those suffering following cyclone Nargis.
