**Key Points from Parish Council's December meeting**

The Council welcomed the generous grant from the Wellness Foundation for the work of the Northbourne Community Centre in 2010.

The lease with the kindergarten has been renewed to 31 December 2014. The annual rent will increase to \$31,000 on 1 January 2010 and increase by \$1,000 per year to \$35,000 by 2014.

New security lighting has been installed at the Rectory.

The 2010 Covenant concluded between Rebecca, the Bishop and the Parish is available in the foyer.

The Council is compiling a list of refurbishment/maintenance items for the Church and grounds to be used for the discussion of priorities for 2010. Thoughts or concerns of parishioners in this regard should be passed to Ian or Roger.
