KEY POINTS FROM THE APRIL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

The Parish Council warmly welcomed advice from Anglicare that it would provide funding of \$23,000 a year for the next three years for Robin's work at the Northbourne Community Centre. This is the first long term funding Anglicare has ever provided to the Centre.

The building/courtyard proposal is being pursued vigorously. A Project Committee has been formed made up of Catherine Holt, Roger Sharp, Leighton Mann, Tim Gulliver and Rebecca Newland.

The aim if possible is to have a fully developed proposal for consideration by an extraordinary Parish Meeting in May.

The Parish Council invites expressions of interest in being the Coordinator for this year's Twilight Fair to be held on 10 November. The Coordinator or Coordinators will be supported by an experienced Fair Committee.
