The Parish Council has previously advised that once the contract is signed we will enter a very busy relocation and installation phase. That stage is now upon us. Prior to installation there is a lot of work to prepare the site and relocate parish assets. After installation there will also be a busy phase when we construct the veranda deck, ramp and steps.

An initial working bee will be held on Saturday 13 April 9am to 12 noon for garden clearance work and sleeper and pergola removal. The next working bee will be held on Saturday 20 April 9am to 12 noon to move the contents of Pandora's small shed to the Rectory garage, dismantle and relocate the small shed and extra pergola work if needed. Pandora's will be able to operate normally during these working bees.
