### *Key Points from May Parish Council Meeting*

- As yet there is still no revised date for Rebecca's resignation. The Rector's Warden and the Parish members of the Clergy Appointment Board are in discussion with the Diocese about locum issues and processes. In the meantime the Council is most grateful to Jeannette for officiating at services and taking on some other Parish roles.
- The Clergy Conference took place in Narooma from 18 to 21 May. Jeannette, Andrea and Peter Kuot attended.
- Parish Council is most grateful to Elizabeth Allinson for taking on the sacristan role until the next AGM in February 2016.
- The hearing loop has been tested. Seating towards the centre of the church, will give you the best reception.
- There has been discussion with the Pelican Foundation about the possibility of continued funding for the cross-cultural program for 2016. Whether the Foundation will be in a financial position to support any projects in 2016 will not become clear until July.
- Andrea will conduct a Workshop for Dinka leaders on Saturday 6 June as part of capacity building under the cross-cultural program.
- Parish Council will organise clearance of the acorns on the nature strip in view of the hazard they present.
