## Psalm 16

- 1 Preserve me, O God:  
for in you have I taken refuge.
- 2 I have said to the Lord, You are my lord:  
and all my good depends on you.
- 3 As for those who are held holy on the earth:  
the other gods in whom people delight,
- 4 Though the idols are many that they run after:  
their offerings of blood I will not offer, nor take their name upon my lips.
- 5 The Lord is my appointed portion and my cup:

## From the Rector

Dear Friends,

Thank you all for celebrating last weekend with such joy and commitment. It was a wonderful three days, thank you for your hard work.

At the Eucharist on Thursday we heard from Luke's gospel of the appearance of the risen Jesus to his disciples. It is I, myself, not a ghost not some disembodied spirit, he says to them. And then today in John's gospel Jesus tells Thomas to touch him, his hands and his side. These appearances help us to understand what it is that we strive for as Christians. Beyond loving God and neighbour our thinking always tends towards the end of our lives and then some vague hope of our 'souls' being transported to heaven; but this is not Christian thinking. The risen Jesus is flesh and blood; the risen Jesus did not enter paradise, he is paradise. Heaven is not a place beyond the sky, it is the risen Christ, the body of Christ living by love, the beginning of risen humankind, the ultimate future of humanity. This sharing in the bodily life of Christ is what the Eucharist is all about.

Today Sam Mahony is to be baptised into this Body, the Body of Christ. None of us reach our potential in this life, we are all restricted by whatever it is that holds us back. But it is our hope that our redeemed bodies will be like his glorious body, free of impediment and we work and minister among each other to make up for the shortfalls in the body, offer that freedom and catch just a glimpse of the hope that is ours. Congratulations Sam, we are overjoyed to welcome you, with us, as a child of the one heavenly Father.
