Farewell from Canon Scott and Lisa

Canon Scott and Lisa will finish up at St Philip's on Sunday 17 March, when Scott will cover for the 8am and 10am Eucharists in Emma's absence interstate. Scott writes:

"Following years of soul searching and six months of inquiries, Lisa and I are to be received into the Roman Catholic Church in the Easter season. I will then enter formal discernment with Roman authorities with a view to being ordained as a Catholic priest in Canberra. Archbishop Prowse has been very welcoming and supportive of this possibility, and I leave with Bishop Mark's blessing. In any event I will be continuing as a Research Professor of Theology based at Charles Sturt University. This move is not a divorce but a leaving of home, with a sense of sadness but also of anticipation. I will bring the gifts I have received from Anglicanism into the Universal Church. Lisa joins me in thanking St Philip's for its warm welcome these last six years, which we will not forget."
