Dear Friends,

Ash Wednesday falls on 14th February 2024 and there will be 10am and 7pm services that day to mark the beginning of Lent.

I recently invited everyone to offer ideas for a communal Lenten study and was encouraged to take up the ABM 2024 Study "God's Own Country". Thousands of individuals, and hundreds of parishes across Australia will be united through this one study. Based on the Seven Days of Creation and with beautiful paintings by the Rev'd Aunty Robyn Davis, First Nations leaders and clergy from the Anglican Church offer theological insights and personal reflections that help us to hear the voices of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of faith.

Seven weeks of study will commence in the week beginning 12th February. You might take it up individually, within a group of family or friends, or join a group at the church lead by me. I am happy to offer a weekday and a Thursday evening group. There will be a sign-up sheet in the Narthex this Sunday.
